- Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, Museum and Ho Chi Minh's house
- One Pillar Pagoda - significant Buddhist pagoda
- Enjoy Hanoi's narrow streets and the fascinating old quarter
- See the Water Puppet Theatre – traditional entertainment.
- Board a traditional junk boat (Bhaya cruise) for a boat trip through the magical seascape of Halong Bay
- Overnight train Hanoi – Hue
- Boat trip on the Perfume River to Thien Mu Pagoda built in 1601. Khai Dinh Tomb with its mix of Asian and Western architecture. Travel over the spectacular Hai Van Pass, once rated by National Geographic as one of the 50 'must-do' journeys in the world.
- Marble mountain Stonecutters
- Hoi An with its charming cobblestone streets and old shop houses. A wonderful town for getting clothes tailor made
- Ancient ruins of My Son – home of Cham people centuries ago.
- Hoi An's Famous Lanterns & Colourful Riverside Market.
- Boat cruise to offshore islands in Nha Trang Bay.
- Ponagar Cham Towers, Long Son Pagoda, Nha Trang Cathedral
- Summer residence of Vietnam's last emperor, Bao Dai.

- Boat to Tan Thach. Stop to visit a local coconut candy workshop; taste candy (local special product).
- Boat trip along the mighty Mekong River and its tributaries to view the daily lives of people who work and play on the waterways of the Mekong Delta. The trip includes a visit to the unique "floating" market at Cai Be
- Cu Chi tunnels, just outside Ho Chi Minh City. During the war for independence, "Viet Cong" guerillas built the labyrinth of narrow tunnels virtually underneath U.S. bases. See how rural people live and work. Stop by Tay Ninh head temple to take part in Midday service. Visit the Reunification Palace, Notre Dame Cathedral, Saigon Post Office, Chinatown, Binh Tay Market and Thien Hau Temple.
- Air Travel to Phnom Penh - Delve into the ancient past at the National Museum or struggle to make sense of the Khmer Rouge "Killing Fields" and museum
- Fly to Siem Reap. Visit - Bakong, Prah ko, and Lolei temples. Followed by the Terrace of Elephant, Leper King, Former Royal Palace, Baphun, Prah Pithu, and the North & South Khleang temples.
- Visit the major and better known of the Angkor Temples
- Excursion to Kbal Spean, about 40 Km. from Siem Reap. Also known as The River of the Thousand Lingas (Hindu images)
- Visit the Great Lake - Tonle Sap for a boat trip to see the floating village.
